Minutes

Rob Leiden, KR2L, made a motion to accept the minutes of the Board Meeting held on September 5, 2002 as published in SARA News. Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR, seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

George Williams, W2CSN, presented the Treasurer's Report. Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR, made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded by Jerry Crawmer, KE2JJ, and it passed unanimously.

New Members: None presented.

Correspondence

Tim Long, W2UI, reported that we had received several membership renewals, several area club newsletters, a request to provide communications for the Schenectady Christmas Parade, an announcement of the Hudson Division Cabinet Meeting, and bank statements since the last Board Meeting.

VE sessions

Paul Siemers, WY2F reports that Bill Mischler, KG2AC will continue as the VE Session Coordinator. To date, Bill has not received any requests to offer exams.

Repeater Committee

John Domblewski, N2OJY reported that the 220 repeater has been off the air since the wind blew the radome off of the earth station and broke one of our 220 antennas in the process. The 147.06 repeater is working fine.

John Domblewski, N2OJY announced that he would allow us to use the Leonard Communications copy machine to duplicate SARA News. Under the terms of the agreement, we will provide paper and the labor. John will provide the toner.

Membership No Report.

Public Relations

Rob Leiden, KR2L, continues to FAX announcements and information about SARA events to local newspapers. Rob has also sent FAX's and emails to the local cable channels and has not received any response. Dan Whelan, N2UD will contact Rotterdam Mall and explore the possibilities of holding a Special Event of some kind at the Mall.

Programs

Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR, announced that all programs for the year had been scheduled.

Old Business-

George Williams, W2CSN presented a proposed balanced budget for the 2002-2003 year. After some discussions and modifications, Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR made a motion to table further discussions until next month when George will present a revised budget. Clark Gittinger, KG2AO seconded the motion.

Rob Leiden, KR2L reported that we had received a firm commitment from Niskayuna High School to use their New Cafeteria as our meeting place beginning with the November meeting. Their standard fee is \$63 per use. They are considering waiving the fee for us. If we leave it in the same condition that we find it, there will be no custodial fee. If we use the kitchen, the extra fee is \$25 per use. Niskayuna High School will not be available for the March 3rd meeting and we will make alternate arrangements. Dan Whelan, N2UD made a motion to change meeting venues and to authorize the Treasurer to pay up to \$63 per use for use of the facility. Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

New Business

Bob Raffaelle, W2XM, has decided not to pursue offering an amateur radio class for this Fall. There was insufficient student interest. Bob will organize a class for the Fall of 2003 with the new curriculum which has yet to be determined.

John Domblewski, N2OJY reported that the 220 repeater was not working. We had been using separate transmit and receive antennas making a duplexer unnecessary. One of the antennas was recently destroyed during a wind storm. The other antenna is in fine shape on the tower. John received a quotation of \$901 plus shipping (his cost) for a duplexer which would allow both transmit and receive functions on the same antenna. Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR made a motion to buy a duplexer at John's cost not to exceed \$1000. George Williams, W2CSN seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Millie Gittinger, KB2SWR, made a motion to adjourn at 9:00 PM and Paul Siemers, WY2F, concurred

Directions to the Niskayuna High School New Cafeteria

Enter the school grounds at the traffic light just north of the Nott Street major intersection on Balltown Road. Drive to the road intersection in front of the main school entrance, and turn right at this intersection. Drive around to the back of the school, past a narrow point where the school and the adjacent shopping center are close together. Park in the first area of the rear parking lot that you come to. Enter the school at the entrance near to a large circular fan mounted on the side of the wall of the nearby building extension. (This extension has some fenced in electrical boxes at its end.) The new cafeteria is across the hall from the entrance.

For those of us who want to play with GPS units, the entrance doorway is at N 42deg. 49.070min., W 73deg. 53.325min.
