Minutes: - Paul Siemers, WY2F, made a motion to accept the minutes as published in SARA News. George Williams, W2CSN, seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: - George Williams, W2CSN, presented the Treasurer's Report. Paul Siemers, WY2F made a motion to accept the report. The motion was seconded by Gerry Crawmer, KE2JJ and it passed unanimously.

New Members: - None presented.

Correspondence: - Tim Long, W2UI, reported that, since the last Board Meeting, we had received a monthly bank statement, a monthly phone statement, the Dayton Hamfest announcement, the monthly Squelch Tale, and an annual bill for our post office box rental. One renewal was received via the mail.

Repeater Committee: - Scott Krone, N2YCA is the site manager at the repeater site and provided a written report of all repeater activity. Clark Gittinger, KG2AO offered a cavity.

Public Service: - President Dennis Hudson, N2LBT, and the Board would like to remind all members that we are a public service club and encourages everyone to participate in public service events.

Newsletter: - Clark again reminded the Board that a new SARA News Editor will be needed soon.

Membership: - We mailed 82 copies and e-mailed another 49 copies.

Public Relations: - Still need chairperson. Newsletters were mailed to the Gazette and to the Times Union. Announcements of club meetings are appearing in these newspapers.

Programs: - George Williams, W2CSN, is ready for the May program. During the June meeting, we will conduct our annual business meeting, present the Broughton Award, and announce Field Day plans. We may have a short home movie of SARA's Field Day Operation in 1938. The SARA Board will meet on June 3rd to discuss Field Day preparations.

VE Sessions: - No requests received.

RFI: - No report.

Field Day: - George Williams, W2CSN, is our Field Day Chairman this year. Volunteers came forward and duties were assigned. Other potential volunteers were discussed. Bob Raffaele, W2XM, will set up a GOTA station in the Schenectady County Emergency van (C100). We may see a visitor from the East (Rob Leiden, K1UI, ex KR2L, may visit from Cape Cod). This is our biggest annual event. We should all provide all the support that we can.

Old Business:

Nominating Committee – Candidates are currently being sought and selected for officers and board positions. Broughton Committee – Bob Raffaele, W2XM, is the chairman assisted by Dan Whelan, N2UD and Tim Long, W2UI. The Broughton Award will be presented at the June 7th meeting.

New Business:

What is the future of SARA? Our 75th Anniversary is just around the corner. This item was tabled for next month.

Bob Raffaele, W2XM, in e-mail to the Board, stated that the Ham Classes that he has been organizing are becoming increasingly more difficult to staff. Instructors are hard to find and the number of classes that each instructor has to teach is becoming burdensome. Bob's e-mail explained that an ARRL videotape was available for \$161, was designed for self-study, and could be supplemented with instructors as they are available. George Williams, W2CSN, made a motion to authorize the purchase of the ARRL videotape. Ramsey Seielstad, KC2GMW, seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Paul Siemers, WY2F, made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:33 PM.
