VHF and UHF Operations Over the Summer

Quite a few of SARA's members kept busy on the VHF through Microwave bands over the summer. Two big contests happened, the June VHF contest and the UHF Contest in early August. Many of our members participate from home stations, big multi operator stations such as W2SZ or traveling on the road to various "Grids" to give points from sparsely populated areas. Some of our members who operated as "UHF/Microwave Rovers" during the August UHF Contest included KB2HQ, N2UD, N2LBT and many others. Reminder September VHF Contest

Just a reminder that the September VHF contest will be the on the weekend before the SARA meeting starting at 2pm on Saturday September 9 and running through 11 pm on Sunday September 10th. Operations will be on all bands and modes from 6 meters up through the microwave bands.

Those with even just an FM mobile rig or home station with a modest antenna can try their hands by going to the FM (simplex only - no repeaters) frequencies in each band. On Two meters the use of 146.52 (the national simplex calling frequency) is excluded, but adjacent frequencies such as 146.55 and 146.58 simplex have a fair amount activity. You will also find VHF contest activity on FM on 52.525, 223.5 and 446.0 as well. Of course those with multi-mode SSB/CW rigs will find activity all around 50.200, 144.200 and 432.100 MHz.

The exchange to make contest contacts will include your

call and "grid square". Local grid squares are "FN32" Schenectady County east of Thruway/I-88 exit 25A, eastern Albany County, and the southern part of Saratoga County south of Ballston Spa; "FN33" in Saratoga north of Ballston Spa, Washington and southern Warren Counties; "FN22" for Western Schenectady County west of Thruway Exit 25A for I88 and Amsterdam area; "FN23" in Parts of Saratoga north and west of Galway as well as Fulton Country.
