# A Practical Application of "Abstract" Transmission-line Theory With Bob Raffaele, W2XM

At the April 2nd SARA meeting, after explaining a subtlety of impedance, and then summarizing how to use the Smith Chart, W2XM explains how he arrived at the parameters for his dipole antenna system. With a stub connected near the transmitter end of the transmission line, the system SWR at 3850 is about 1:1; without the stub, resonance shifts to 3550.

The SARA meeting will be at 7 PM at the Niskayuna High School in the "new cafeteria" toward the rear of the building. As you pull into Niskayuna High School from the traffic light on Balltown road come toward the main entrance and then turn right. Follow the road around the side of the school and there is parking along that side. The "new cafeteria" is right near the double doors toward the middle of that side of the school. The school is on Balltown Road roughly about 2 miles north of the intersection of Route 7 (Crosstown Arterial) and Balltown Road.
