Azden: The Inside Story of a Supplier to the Ham Radio Market

We are fortunate at the November SARA meeting to have a presentation by one of our members with a very special insight into the business side of amateur radio and equipment manufacturing. Sid Wolin K2LJH has been a ham for 55 years. He is an electronics engineer specializing in rf and microwave design, having worked mostly on surveillance, electronics warfare, receiving and transmitting equipment. On the military/commercial side he worked for 24 years for a 300 employee company, becoming executive vice president. A few years after retiring from that job he formed Azden Corporation based on his 40 years experience (at that time) as a radio amateur. He owned Azden and contracted with Japanese firms to manufacture the products for the American ham market. Azden competed in the high end of the market against the likes of ICOM, Kenwood, Yaesu and others. As time went by and he couldn't find a buyer for the company so he eventually shut it down and became a consultant in the ham radio market for other manufacturers until he retired again. So join us Monday at 7PM on November 5th as Sid K2LJH will give us a grand tour of the business side of the hobby that we all have known so well yet may be so mysterious in how it works to bring us the radios we all enjoy.

About The SARA Meeting Location

Monitoring NOAA Weather Radio Stations - by Dan Whelan - N2UD

Many of the newer “Weather Radios” have programmable alerting which use codes for each of the counties affected by an alert. This is sent with an “event code” for the type of alert. These messages are usually with a code for the Warning (imminent threats) or Watch (possible threats) that signifies the type of event such as a tornado, flash flood, child abduction, blizzard, severe storm, etc. Receivers can be programmed to be selective for geographic area as well as the type of warnings or watches you want the radio to activate for. The radio’s manual gives programming instructions and a list of codes.

Below is a listing of the geographic areas (county code # sometimes called a “FIPS code”) for the northeastern part of New York State. Also listed are the specific NOAA Weather radio transmitters which cover that county. Usually the first station is the one which should be tried first. Note in Schenectady and Albany Counties we should monitor the 162.550 MHz signal which comes from a transmitter in the Helderbergs. Also note that Schoharie County is covered by FOUR different NOAA weather radio transmitters because of its difficult mountain terrain, all of which should provide warning info for that county area. Remember, if you hear “out of area” weather stations they may not carry all of the critical warnings for your county.
