in "the Little Theater" Room D-104 at Niskayuna High School

DIGITAL TELEVISION BROADCASTING (Remember Analog over-the air TV broadcasts END on 2/17/2009!)

The November SARA Meeting will feature a presentation on the Digital TV Broadcast transition by Rich Klein - WB2TBG, Chief Engineer of local NBC Affiliate WNYT Channel 13. Rich will give us his perspective on the changes DTV is bringing to his station, the TV broadcast industry in general and what it will mean to those of us who watch TV.

The changeover to digital transmission for "off air" TV is mandated by the FCC to happen on February 17, 2008. By that date the consumers who receive TV broadcasts with antennas will need to equip themselves with either new digital TV sets or obtain a special DTV tuner which will receive the new digital transmissions and convert them to the lower resolution pictures that can be watched on a conventional older NTSC standard TV set. People who subscribe to cable television will still receive TV signals as normal and need not buy a special DTV converter box. To receive the wide screen format, higher resolution pictures one of the new HDTVs would be required however. Those who use satellite TV service such as DirecTV or Dish Network will need to check their equipment configuration since some equipment additions or changes may be required for reception of the local broadcast TV channels.

Interested in VHF/UHF/Microwave Operations? - by Dan Whelan – N2UD

There are several very specialized ham “VHF clubs” which are involved with the highly technical aspects of operation and construction of equipment to operate in these higher frequency ham bands. One of the norms for operating on many of these bands is the need to

construct some major portion of all of your equipment and antennas. It is among the most interesting challenges for many hams who want to “push the envelope” of their skills and is about as far away from being one of those dreaded “appliance operators” as one can be! Some of these clubs have websites and news letters with lots of useful information and here is a listing of some of the most active ones listed by Gene Zimmerman W3ZZ for his QST column “World Above 50 Mhz”.

Noteworthy among this group is the Northeast Weak Signal Group which meets a half a dozen times a year in Enfield CT and sponsors the Eastern VHF Conference each year. Another major operating group in the region is the Mount Greylock Expeditionary Force which is the group behind the world class operation of W2SZ/1 and one of the leaders among them is Dick Frey WA2AAU who is one of our

local hams (and a Broughton Award recipient) who frequently has done presentations on VHF for SARA in years past. And don't forget the winter is a good time to work on VHF and up projects and test out new equipment and antennas. And the January VHF contest is only about 10 weeks away!

DECEMBER SARA MEETING:

The upcoming meeting on December 1st 2008 is going to be the annual holiday meeting and it will be held at Old Country Buffet on Albany Street next to the Crosstown Arterial (Rt.7).
