## SARA Meeting January 4

## Traffic and Emergency Nets

Larry Eaton NT2B will talk about the various traffic and emergency nets we hear on the air in the area. He will focus on the organization of the traffic nets and their relationship to one another, covering the National Traffic System (NTS) and independent nets. He will also speak about some of the local emergency nets. His talk will also cover how to get involved and sources of training materials.

Larry is an experienced traffic handler, has handled traffic on Local, Section, and Region nets, and is Net Control on Second Region at 6:30 on Sunday nights and for the Schenectady County Emergency Net 75-Meter Section. He is a frequent participant in Public Service Events and hospital emergency communications drills, has completed the ARRL Amateur Radio Emergency Communications Course (ARECC) Levels I, II, and III, the ARRL Digital Emergency Communications Course, and is a mentor in the ARECC Program.

**Location:** SARA meetings are held in Niskayuna High School in the "Little Theater" Room D-104. Due to construction access is from the rear parking lot, off Nott Street Extension. Turn onto Nott Street Extension from Balltown Road and drive past the shopping mall on the left. The entrance is on the left side of the road and marked.


