Mohawk River Flooding By Tim Long, W2UI

A year ago, while watching the Mohawk ice from the Stockade Section, Tim met John Garver and Jackie Cockburn, two Geology professors at Union College. They invited him to a colloquium on the Mohawk River Watershed that was to be held at Union. John was eager to obtain the river data that SARA members collected and reported because he had just installed a few gages in the river that had yet to be calibrated. At the colloquium, Tim learned that data SARA members had collected validated his theories and why John had chosen to put the gages in the river where he did. He also found out why the river always seems to flood in the same place. It all started 10,000 years ago. For the rest of the story, come to the SARA meeting.

Tim was first licensed in 1961 and has been a SARA member since 1974. He has served on the SARA board for many years, and has held all the officer positions, all more than once. He is a Broughton Award recipient and has been Field Day Chairman many years, and is currently Treasurer, and Chairman of the Elmer and Antenna Party Committees. In addition to his club roles, Tim is also RACES Radio Officer and Skywarn Emergency Coordinator for Schenectady County

SARA Website Changes

Change has come to the SARA website. There are two new Google Calendars on the website; one named SARA-Meetings, on the Home page, and a second named SARA-PSE, on the Public Service Events page. These calendars have been added to facilitate quick access to information as well as easing the burden of updating the website. There are some other changes that may be of interest.

A number of other changes have been made as part of the routine information updating required of any webpage. We're working on a number of other changes to the SARA website. If you notice anything else that needs to be updated or changed, please let Dennis know.

SARA-Meetings Calendar

On the Home page, immediately below the General Meeting announcement, there is now a searchable calendar that displays all SARA meetings and events. This is the SARA-Meetings calendar. All calendar items from the website will be displayed here. Items from the SARA-Meetings calendar are displayed in blue and items from the SARA-PSE calendar are displayed in red.

Navigation In the blue bar at the top of the calendar are a number of features that can be quite helpful. In the upper left-hand corner this calendar is labeled SARA-K2AE.

Date Menu Just below the label is the date of the item currently being displayed. Immediately to the right of the date is a drop-down menu with a gray downward pointing triangle. Moving your cursor anywhere over the date causes the drop-down menu to become active and the background of the triangle will change to white. Click the triangle to open the menu and a calendar will appear allowing you to select the time period you want to review.

Tabs To the right of the date menu are three tabs labeled Week, Month, and Agenda. These tabs (respectively) allow display of the calendar a week at a time, a month at a time, or in a two-row format displaying only days on which meetings and events have been recorded.

Week This displays the days of the week in columns and 24 hours of each day in rows. When the display is set to a week in which the current date falls, the current day is displayed with a light-yellow background (as opposed to the default white background) and the current time is marked with an orange bar. Use the slider control on the right to change the time.

In the row between the data and date and the daily displays is a summary row. If an all-day event is listed for that day an indicator appears in this summary row. To see how this works, take a look at the Field Day entry on June 26-27.

Month Choosing the Month tab displays six weeks at a time. This display is in a two-row format for each week, with the first row displaying the date of each day of each week on a light blue background and the information on a white background. Clicking on an item brings up the details.

Agenda When displaying in the two-row format, the date row is displayed on a light-blue background and the event row on a white background. Clicking anywhere in the event row will bring up a detail summary of the event. Anytime you have meeting or event details displayed, you can access a map, get further details, or download the meeting or event details to your Google Calendar.



Calendar Selection Drop-Down To the right of the tabs is another drop-down menu. The SARA-K2AE calendar (on the home page) displays items listed in both the SARA-K2AE and SARA-Public Service calendars. This drop-down menu allows users to select the calendar items they wish to view. Items may be displayed from the one or both of the calendars. This also allows users to select none as an option (the benefit of which is not yet understood by the author).

SARA-PSE Calendar

A second new calendar on the SARA website, the SARA-Public Service calendar, displayed on the Public Service Events webpage. Items listed in this calendar are displayed both here and in the SARA-Meetings calendar on the Home page.

While the SARA-PSE calendar was originally intended for Public Service Events, current plans are to use it to display other events, such as Winterfest and Field Day, allowing for easy differentiation of events from meetings on the SARA-Meetings calendar. This is expected to allow quicker access to information
