Prior to his broadcast radio career he worked at KAPL for Control Data Corp. from 1967 to 1989 as a systems engineer with 6600's 7600's Cray designed computers. 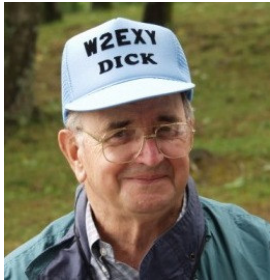

Richard H. Marshall, W2EXY (SK)



Richard H. "Dick" Marshall, W2EXY, of Ransomville, became a silent key on Tuesday, March 23, 2010. Born March 21, 1928 in Niagara Falls, NY, he lived in Johnstown, NY, and then Canajoharie, NY, where he graduated from high school in 1946. After graduation Dick ran a radio repair shop in Canajoharie. In 1949 he returned to Niagara Falls briefly, settling in Ransomville in 1950 where he remained for the rest of his life. Dick was an active amateur, Net Control for the Carrier Net on Saturday mornings, a volunteer radio operator at various American Red Cross functions, and spent time with fellow amateurs over the years.

Frank "Douglas" LaViska, KA2DXK (SK)

Frank "Douglas" LaViska, KA2DXK, of Ballston Spa, passed away on Wednesday, March 24, 2010. Frank was born in Schenectady on November 14, 1938. Frank was a 1957 graduate of Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake Schools, retired from the U.S. military, serving with the U.S. Marine Corps and transferred to the federal technician program with the U.S. Army, retiring in 1995. He was an avid outdoorsman enjoying hunting, fishing skiing, boating and marksmanship. Frank enjoyed HF and had been active in Saratoga RACES, served on the Board, participated in Field Day, and helped with several hamfests, walkathons, and other events. He was generous with his time in assisting other amateurs, helping everyone who needed it no matter what. While Frank's involvement in the hobby waned in recent years, he is fondly remembered as a friend and advocate of amateur radio.
