Modern Amateur Equipment

The Schenectady Amateur Radio Association (SARA) will hold its February meeting with a presentation by SARA member and Board member Sid Wolin K2LJH on what's new in amateur radio equipment. Sid has been a ham for over 55 years. He is an electronics engineer specializing in rf and microwave design, having worked mostly on surveilelectronics warfare, receiving lance. transmitting equipment. On the military/commercial side he worked 24 years for a 300 employee company, becoming executive vice president. Based on Sid's years of experience in the electronic industry and as a amateur radio operator, and his continuing contacts with the industry has keep him abreast of developments in amateur radio equipment.

The SARA meeting will be held Monday, February 7, 2011 at 7 PM in the Little Theatre of the Niskayuna High School on Balltown Road.. Attendees should enter the school through the cafeteria entrance located on the side of the school, adjacent to the Nott Street Extension school parking lot.

Amateur radio operators and interested individuals are invited to attend.

Winterfest 2011

Members of local Amateur Radio clubs, unaffiliated amateurs, and the Capital District Traffic Net will be promoting amateur radio in a demonstration at Winterfest 2011 at Indian Meadows Park in the Town of Glenville. This year Winterfest is scheduled for February 5, 2011 from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Assuming no emergencies, we'll again be using the Schenectady County Emergency Command Vehicle, also known as the C100. This provides us with a comfortable, heated operating location that's hard to miss.

We'll have both 2-Meter and 20-Meter rigs in operation. On 2-Meters, we'll be using SARA's 147.060 repeater with the 147.300 repeater as backup. On 20-Meters, we're planning on being at 14.270 or thereabouts.

Our primary goal is to provide an opportunity for event attendees to learn about amateur radio, see it in operation, get on the air and participate in making contacts. They can also send Radiograms from the event. In past years, experienced amateurs have introduced non-amateur attendees as well as Elmering amateurs looking to get some DX experience.

All amateurs are welcome to participate either at the event or from another location, be it from home, mobile, or someplace else. At Indian Meadows, we're looking Continued on page 3
