Schenectady Boy Scouts need your help

The Schenectady District Boy Scouts are holding their Spring Camporee on Saturday 4-30-2011. They have asked us to do the same thing we did last year at the event.

Their program starts at 0900, where Patrols of 5-12 Scouts roam the Camp and attend different venues. We will be one of the venues. There may be 12 venues and possibly a total of 200 boys. It will run until 1600 with lunch at about noon. Last year we had several Patrols at our venue at one time.

Last year we had 4 stations set up. Two VHF and two HF. One VHF was 2m phone (not used as much as others) and the other was 2m packet. Jeff operated the 2m packet, but I don't know if he will make it this year. On HF, I will put up 2 wire antennas ahead of time. One will be a 20 meter dipole and the other a G5RV. Bill Proctor will bring his Buddi Pole. It would be nice to have 3 HF stations. I will bring my rig (IC-7000) with tuner, I will have my laptop ready to run PSK-31 and phone. If Peter could bring his rig, he could run CW or phone. Lee said he could demo CW, don't know if he comes complete with rig. We could have one more rig on the Buddi Pole, perhaps we could borrow one of the club's IC-706, unless someone else wants to bring theirs.

Last year on HF we really only had 40 and 20 meters. Sunspots are good this year, I am sure 15m will be open and maybe 10m. We could have CW and phone on different bands. I will conduct an introduction for new Patrols entering our venue.

I will set up one of my 2m rigs for phone.

All I need to know now is who will be able to attend and man the stations. Please advise.

The task list has been updated and is ready to be filled in with volunteers willing to do the task(s). It is a long list! SARA has been using computers to do the logging chore for many years now and CT has been the logging program used for all of them. CT is no longer being updated and is no longer supported. N1MM Logger has been the contesters' logging program of choice for several years now. It is free and actively supported. You should become familiar with N1MM if you are not already. I will have a demo running at the next SARA meeting.

SARA's computer monitors are currently the CRT variety, are heavy, bulky, and filling my basement. If you have an LCD monitor that is collecting dust and if you would like to donate it to the SARA effort, please contact me ASAP. Likewise, wireless networking cards would eliminate ethernet cables.

So, setup begins at 2 PM local time on Friday, June 24th. We start collecting and moving stuff on Friday morning. On-the-air operations start at 2 PM local time on Saturday, June 25th, continue for 24 hours, and end at 2 PM on Sunday, June 26th. Tear-down begins promptly at 2:01 PM. The well deserved rest can start as early as 5:00. Be aware and be prepared. Set aside as much time as you can allow. NO RAIN!
