**IT'S FIELD DAY TIME AGAIN !**

Once again it's time to brave the elements, the bugs, the QRM, etc. and enjoy the fun of being with your fellow hams while operating away from the home station. This year's Field Day is Sat. June 25 and Sun. June 26 at our usual location- the field behind the Glenville Hills Fire Dept. on Ridge Rd. in Glenville (directions below).

Again this year; the club has a modern, 10 KW commercial generator (your club dues at work!). This generator has been tested and should be ready to provide us with all the power we need, in a small, fuel efficient package. As we have in the past, we will be running five stations simultaneously, plus a get-on-the air (GOTA) station. Also, as in the past, we expect to have the county's C100

emergency communications van on site. Free food, snacks, and soft drinks will be provided by the club for those who participate (Who says there's no free lunch!).

Want to get involved but don't feel like operating, we need help with setup, teardown, cooking, logging, and misc. other jobs. Serious site setup will begin on the morning of Friday June 24. Teardown will begin shortly after noon on Sunday and will continue for at least several hours. Antenna setup has been simplified compared to several years ago. We only use one tower (a crank-up, tilt-over); all other antennas are wire type and are supported on guyed fiberglass poles. This has proven to save time and damage to various body parts. If you can pull on a rope or hold a pole-WE NEED YOU. Logging/ duping is by computer, but not to worry- we don't do Windows! The logging program we will be using is new this year, but operator friendly, and has been tested (by someone who should know). With the "cheat sheets" it should be easy to use.

For those who like to operate, there are plenty of opportunities to do so. We will have six complete stations set up in the tent- 5 on the air at a time, plus a spare. Depending on your operating preference these can be used on SSB or CW. You don't have to be a "contester" to participate. We especially need operators after dark, so if you're a "night owl" and want to have some fun please come on up. Are you a new licensee (or an old

timer who's feeling rusty), this is the perfect opportunity to get on the air and get some experience.

Even if you don't want to operate and are unable to help with setup or teardown, come up anyway. Renew old friendships in person (The only tweeting here is coming from the speakers of the rigs). The idea is to get out and have fun. As a side benefit, we test our operating skills and preparation for emergency communications work.

If you can help, please contact this year's Field Day chairman- Frank Simon - WB2PUH at 477-5255 or "Field Day Chairman Emeritus"- Tim Long W2UI. No reservations are required to operate a rig, but if you can help please call.

My latest fun has been to build and test 3 computer interfaces to send CW using N1MM Logger. They replace the CT keying interfaces and one side benefit is there is no 9V battery required. Yea!

If I have enough time, I will also build and test 3 computer interfaces to send digital audio from the computer sound card. N1MM Logger has this functionality built-in as well.

So, setup begins at 2 PM local time on Friday, June 24th. We start collecting and moving stuff on Friday morning. On-the-air operations start at 2 PM local time on Saturday, June 25th, continue for 24 hours, and end at 2 PM on Sunday, June 26th. Tear-down begins promptly at 2:01 PM.
